In the gospel for the first weekend of Lent, we hear Jesus say, "Repent, and believe in the gospel." A translation of the word "repent" can be understood as "turning around" or "turning toward" God. This year consider the opportunity to turn toward God with others in a small group for five weeks of Lent and one week after Easter.

You can sign up either online or after the Masses starting next weekend. The sessions will begin the week of February 18 and topics will include:

Week 1: Turning toward God - Gain some insights on prayer and other small habits that will strengthen your relationship with God and others. Learn some techniques to help with times of dryness, distractions, and discouragement.

Week 2: God working through Community – From the call of Abraham to Jesus to now, see how God has always worked through a people as a community of believers.

Week 3: Broken and Beloved - The gospel of Jesus' encounter with the Woman at the Well has great insight how God loves and works through the beloved and broken us. Explore the themes of encounter, compassion, mercy and mission.

Week 4: God Comes to a Loved and Broken World - Right now, so many long for a world in which individuals and families can experience peace, livelihood, health and security. Explore how God so loved the (albeit messy) world that he gave his only Son, so that we might have life.

Week 5: How to Understand the Cross as Victory then and now. Explore how to connect our crosses to that of Jesus and still find joy in times of suffering.

Week 6: (after Easter) - Living with Easter Hope. Explore how to grow in the virtues of faith, hope and love because of the mysteries of the risen Lord.

The content will include a teaching on the topics above and some time for discussion and prayer.

Look for more information next week, including available times and ways to sign up for this wonderful opportunity to deepen your faith, get to know others, and strengthen our parish community.

### Presentation of the Lord

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord is Thursday, February 1. This feast commemorates the presentation of the infant Jesus, in the Jerusalem temple forty days after



his birth. At the beginning of the eighth century, Pope Sergius inaugurated a candlelight procession. At the end of the same century the blessing and distribution of candles became part of the celebration, giving the feast its popular name of Candlemas. Candles will be blessed during each of the masses and will be available for you to take and use in your home during this next year.

# Feast of Saint Blaise



The traditional blessing of throats will take place after both masses on Friday, February 2. On the Feast of St. Blaise two candles are blessed, held slightly open and held near the throat as a prayer of blessing is said. Saint Blaise's protection of those with throat troubles apparently comes from a legend that a boy was brought to him who had a fishbone stuck in his throat. The boy

was about to die when Saint Blaise healed him.


