Epiphany Proclamation 2024



The proclamation of the date of Easter and the other moveable feasts on Epiphany dates from a time when calendars were not readily available. It was necessary to make known the date of Easter in advance, since many celebrations of the liturgical year depend on its date. The number of Sundays that follow Epiphany, the date of Ash Wednesday, and the number of Sundays that follow Pentecost are all computed in relation to Easter.



Know, dear brothers and sisters, that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection,

we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On the Fourteenth day of February will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the evening of the Twenty-Eighth day of March will begin the **Easter Triduum**.

On the Thirty-First day of March you will celebrate with joy **Easter Sunday**, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the Ninth day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the Nineteenth day of May, the feast of **Pentecost**.

On the Second day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the First day of December, the **First Sunday of the Advent** of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever.
