Ash Wednesday

The Lenten season begins with Ash Wednesday on Wednesday, February 14. There will be the blessing and distribution of ashes during the masses at 7:00am, 10:00am, 12:00pm and 5:15pm. Please note there will be no confessions on Ash Wednesday.

Lenten Abstinence & Fasting

All who have reached their 14th birthday are asked to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and on all Fridays during Lent. All those between the ages of 18-59 are asked to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. One full meal and two lighter meals are allowed on days of fast. The obligation does not apply to those whose health or work would be seriously affected.

Wednesdays in Lent following the 12:00pm mass in the lower church beginning February 21. Watch the bulletin for details.

Stations of the Cross

On each Friday during Lent at 3:00pm in the church.

How to Fast

Fast from judging others; Feast on Christ dwelling in them.
Fast from apparent darkness; Feast on the reality of light.
Fast from thoughts of illness; Feast on the healing power of God.
Fast from words that pollute; Feast on phrases that purify.

Fast from anger; Feast on patience.

Fast from worry; Feast on unceasing prayer.

Fast from negatives; Feast on positives.


Fast from complaining; Feast on appreciation.

Fast from hostility; Feast on nonresistance.

Fast from bitterness; Feast on forgiveness.

Fast from anxiety; Feast on hope.

Fast from yourself; Feast on a silent heart.

February 22: "Dorothy Day & Catholic Community".


