## Religious Education

Assumption's religious education program completes its first year in our new space on the Assumption campus, we are looking forward to the 2024-2025 year beginning in September. Classes will be held on Saturday mornings during the school year.



Important details to know:

- Regular religious education classes are offered for K-1st and 3rd-7th grade.
- Sacramental preparation class is traditionally offered in 2nd grade for 1st reconciliation and 1st communion.
- Confirmation classes are offered to 8th grade and up.
- Classes for those outside of 2nd grade, who may have missed sacramental preparation for 1st reconciliation and 1st communion.
- There is a sacramental preparation for those kids who have never received any sacraments.

- Baptism is offered to children of all ages.


