This weekend we celebrate Pentecost, the great festival that marks the birth of the Christian church by the power of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost means 'fiftieth day' and is celebrated fifty days after Easter. We celebrate today with joy and thanksgiving for the gift of the Holy Spirit, through whom the Church lives today.

## The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage



The celebration of the Eucharist is the source and summit of our faith in which we gather and encounter Jesus Christ himself, and then we are sent to bring the light of Christ to the world around us. This July, for the first time since 1941, many Catholics around the country will gather at the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, Indiana. To prepare for this historic event, there will be a National Eucharistic Pilgrimage which for Minnesota starts at the headwaters of the Mississippi and will travel through Minnesota, Wisconsin, Illinois onto Indiana.

This pilgrimage will travel through St. Paul on May 27 with a procession beginning at 12:45pm at The Saint Paul Seminary and ending with a prayer service at the Cathedral at 4:00pm. Then, the next morning we are honored to welcome the pilgrimage here at Assumption for a short prayer service before it heads to the next stop at Little Sisters of the Poor. Please join us on **Tuesday, May 28 from 9:25am - 9:50am at Assumption** to be a part of this historic journey of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage.
