Last week, we issued a statement regarding our variance appeal for plans to provide more

supportive housing at Mary Hall, located at 438 Dorothy Day Place. We are making significant progress, engaging in many conversations. I've met with Aeon (a real estate development organization) and Catholic Charities, and while the appeal continues, we have found that many of our concerns align. We have also agreed on the recommendations we will present to local public officials. If successful, this will benefit everyone, including those in need.

Speaking of those in need, as conversations happen, it is important to be mindful of our disposition and language. We are making a case that for balanced, healthy neighborhoods and cities, over-concentration of vulnerable populations is not a long-term solution. We are also addressing the problematic behaviors we observe. In doing so, we must be cautious with our language such as "the poor" or "the homeless" which are easily used in unhelpful ways. It is easy to categorize people into generalized groups or view them as problems to be solved or worse a sense of "us versus them". Each person has dignity and has a story. When we see someone pulling a cart or carrying an old piece of luggage, it might be all they have. Consider how resourceful a person must be to managing basic things we take for granted. Notice the positive aspects of community, friendships and people looking out for each other. We can appreciate the compassion and great service of supportive organizations such as, Catholic Charities and Listening House.

While we address concerns and negative behaviors, we also acknowledge the many positive encounters with our neighbors. Every day, parishioners are in communion with those in need—whether sharing or serving food, sitting and talking, or through other kind interactions. Occasionally, someone will walk by with a big smile and say, "Hey Pastor! Pray for me!" I'll respond, "Okay! Pray for me too!"

When I first started at Assumption, I met one of our parishioners, Pat, who was helping at Listening House. I asked her, "How did you start coming to Listening House?" She replied, "Well, I moved downtown and remembered what Jesus says, 'Love your neighbor.' And who is our neighbor? They are right here." That's the Christian disposition to have.


